GC 76000(e) The \$7 “shall be reduced in each county by the additional penalty amount assessed by the county for the local courthouse construction fund established by Section 76100 as of January 1, 1998, when the money in that fund is transferred to the state under Section 70402.” A chart showing the reduction by county is included in this code section.. The amount payable under GC 76000 varies by county where imposed. (*See People v. Hamed, supra*, 221 Cal.App.4th 928 , 935.)

3. The emergency medical services penalty applies only if the county board of supervisors has elected to impose it.
